Child Care During Morning Worship

Children learn on a different level than adults, so here at Calvary Chapel we have classes designed to teach the children the Word and Love of God on their level. We have Nursery through Kindergarten classes during the entire service. Grades 1 through 6 worship with their parents and are then dismissed. We encourage you to have your children participate in these classes for their benefit and to keep the main service quiet and free from distractions. ATTENTION PARENTS - We teach straight through the Bible and some content of our adult lessons may not be suitable for children.

Calvary Chapel Service Etiquette

In an effort to make the worship experience meaningful and beneficial to all who attend, we have set up the following recommended standards for our time together. Once the service has started, please end your conversations and quietly take your seat. If for some reason you need to leave during the service, we ask that upon your return please sit in the back row to avoid disturbing others. We have coffee available at the kitchen area before service. At 9:00 and 10:30, when the service starts the coffee will be put away until after the service. We ask that you turn off your cell phone and beepers during the service. If you need your cell phone or beeper on for emergency purposes (i.e you are on call, an EMT, etc...) please put them on vibrate. Thank you for helping us to keep the service a pleasant, worship experience for our visitors and everyone in our church family.

Calvary Chapel Offerings

At Calvary Chapel Lebanon, we do not take a formal offering. We hold firm to the scripture found in II Corinthians 9:7 which says "You must each make up your own mind as to how much you should give. Don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. For God loves the person who gives cheerfully." Please do not feel obligated to give. We encourage those who attend regularly to pray and ask God to lead you in this matter. For those who choose to give there are two boxes located on the table near the back doors. One is labeled "Tithes and Offerings", for the general operating budget of the church and the other is labeled "Benevolence" to care for the needs of our church members and the community around us.
